## **Project Highlights**

Sperrinview, Cookstown Whiteabbey Primary School St. Josephs, Belfast Rathore School, Newry





This landmark project for the Education Authority (Northern Ireland) represents the first permanent two-storey modular SEN classroom facility within the framework. The new building expands Sperrinview Special School's Cookstown campus, which supports pupils aged 3–19 with severe learning difficulties, providing enhanced, purpose-built spaces for early-years education and specialist learning support.

Designed to deliver a modern, inclusive environment, the development includes six classrooms with associated support areas, a covered link to the existing school, playground and car park improvements, and internal refurbishment works. The modular units were manufactured offsite to minimise disruption, improve efficiency, and uphold the highest standards of quality and sustainability.









JDC Building Works Ltd successfully completed the Whiteabbey Primary School modular extension project on time and within budget, delivering three new classrooms that blend modern design with the school's existing red-brick heritage architecture.

Commissioned by the Education Authority (NI), the project used modular building techniques to provide spacious, contemporary learning spaces that enhance educational outcomes while complementing the historic structure.

The extension was widely celebrated by school leadership and local stakeholders, highlighting JDC's commitment to quality, reliability, and community impact. The project's success further positions JDC as a leader in sustainable educational infrastructure, creating opportunities for similar modular projects across Northern Ireland.









At St.Joseph's College, Belfast, we delivered a two-storey, steel-framed modular building containing four fully equipped classrooms and a total floor area of 414 m². The result is a modern, air-conditioned teaching facility offering bright and comfortable learning spaces.

The project was handed over fully turnkey, complete with decoration, quality fixtures, and integrated IT systems and interactive teaching aids. For accessibility and safety, the building includes a lift and external staircases for compliant emergency exits.

Despite the challenges of a restricted and fully operational site, the project was completed safely, on schedule, and under budget. The modular design ensures that the entire building can be fully relocated if future school requirements change.



#### RATHORE SCHOOL, NEWRY

Rathore School in Newry received new SEN facilities, including specialist classrooms and two multi-sensory rooms. The school supports pupils aged 3–19 with severe learning difficulties across the Newry and Down region, aiming to nurture lifelong learners in a safe, engaging environment.

The project faced challenges due to the steep, roadside site requiring a major retaining structure and services straddling the boundary. With a tight schedule from April to August, early consultation and structured communication resolved M&E, architectural, and civil layout issues, minimising programme impact.

The project informed JDC's adoption of Autodesk Construction Cloud (ACC) for live, version-controlled updates. Completed on time, within budget, and to the highest standard, it showcases JDC Building Works' expertise in large-scale modular solutions.
